Report of Parish Council Meeting 26 March 2019

Parishioners Matters

A parishioner advised that due to updates to the Mendip transmitter TVs should be retuned on 5 and 19 June.

The remedial work required to be done by Truespeed in Stoneage Lane has still not been undertaken. Clerk to chase via the BANES Highways Streetworks team.

Rural Transport Update

In the short term, First Bus has now promised that the 179 service will not be withdrawn until a viable alternative is in place. A new Rural Transport Partnership Group will be established by B&NES with the intention of ensuring there is a long term solution to the problem of the lack of the rural transport services. That should avoid future surprises and crises like that created by the sudden changes to the 179 service last year.

Finance

The balance of funds is £12,443.97, and excluding the Community Infrastructure Levy funds the balance is £9,399.13.

Improvements to the Appearance of the Parish

It was suggested that some of the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Funds could be used to erect an enhanced "Welcome to Tunley" sign. It was agreed to check the CIL rules to see if this is an appropriate use of these funds and to request a costing for such a sign from highways.

Tunley Clean Up Day - Post meeting report that 13 local residents turned out on Sunday morning 7th April to pick litter along Withyditch and Palmers Lanes, and throughout the village. The volunteers also tidied up the Stoneage Lane flower beds and the area around the "Coal Tub" on the approach to the village from the Bath direction. An enjoyable morning was had by all in the sunshine with 17 bags of litter, weeds and general rubbish collected.

Hello

Dunkerton WI met at Tunley Recreation Centre on 9th April.

The talk this evening was by Mr John Gingell speaking about chocolate - 'From Bean to Bar'. John had worked in the chocolate industry for over 40 years which sometimes meant travelling all over the world. We were all surprised to learn that the best cocoa beans are made within 20° of the equator and that even in 1720 the cocao beans were given the name 'Theobroma' - Ancient Greek for Food of the Gods!

John gave us a fascinating insight into the history of chocolate making in the UK. This included the precise chocolate making methods used over the years to get to the chocolate we all know and love - including the famous 'Fry's Chocolate Cream 'first made in 1866 and which we can still buy today.

He brought to the meeting a huge display of chocolate memorabilia which sent us all back to our childhoods' - this was topped by some delicious samples of chocolate John had made himself using the traditional methods. The same chocolate is not available to buy nowadays as cocoa butter is usually replaced by oils (we all thought that the taste has definitely changed over the years).

We followed John's superb talk with tea, coffee plus home made biscuits and slices made by Elisabeth and Frances.

Then the business started with Elisabeth at the helm this week in Judy's absence. Amongst other things we discussed our trip to Bowood on Tuesday 21st May.

Our next meeting is on Tuesday 14th May at 1915 when we will debate 2019 WI campaigns.
