#### "Remember, remember the fifth of November, gunpowder, treason and plot."

The month of November is characterised by differing acts of "remembering". Of these, the best known is probably "Guy Fawkes Night", or "Bonfire Night" as we called it when we were young. Every year, my friends and I would make a guy. We'd stuff newspaper inside old clothes and put a mask on its head, and position ourselves outside the village newsagents, and call out "Penny for the guy!" hoping to collect enough cash to buy fireworks. Some of these fireworks, notably the bangers and jumping jacks, would be set off prior to November 5th in various parts of our village, annoying neighbours and the local cat population. There are two other acts of "remembering" in November, both arguably more significant than Bonfire Night, and both are solemn acts of commemoration. The first of these is All Saints' and All Souls' Days on the 1st and 2nd of November, which the world calls Halloween. In Christian thinking these days are designed to help us remember all those who've gone before us "with the sign of faith" and who've left us an example of what it means to follow Christ in this world, in the hope of the world to come.

The second is Remembrance Day on November 11th, along with Remembrance Sunday, held on the nearest Sunday - this year it will be on November 10th. On these two days, we recall the sacrifice made by those who lost their lives in war, serving their country. All the parish churches in our benefice will have a service at which the names of those parishioners who died in war will be read out. One of the most moving moments in those services is when someone reads the words inscribed on the memorial in the Kohima War cemetery in India where 1,420 Commonwealth war dead are buried: When you go home, tell them of us and say: "For your tomorrow, we gave our today". As Jesus said: "Greater love has no man than to lay down his life for his friends." And He should know. Every blessing,

## Report of the Parish Council Meeting 19 September 2019

#### **HIGHWAYS**

Visibility & traffic speed when exiting Crossways Park onto the A367

Exiting onto the A367 from the Crossways Park is difficult due to overgrown vegetation and speed of the traffic. Verges have been trimmed and a

request is in with highways to trim the hedge. Highways are also looking at reducing the speed limit here to 50 mph.

#### Roadworks below the Titfield Thunderbolt

A missing manhole cover remains with barriers and a traffic cone which are creating a safety hazard and obstructing the footpath. Truespeed had advised that this is not their site and appears to be due to BT. Truespeed have passed the issue to BANES Highways to resolve.

(Post meeting note: the cone and barriers have been removed and a temporary manhole cover laid over the hole)

#### Withyditch Road Markings

This work was due to be completed in August but had not been done. Cllr McCabe agreed to confirm when this work would be done.

#### Visibility from Church Lane onto A367

The apple trees in Manders Orchard have been pruned back to ensure the visibility at this junction when exiting Church Lane meets the minimum highways safety standard for the speed limits in force.

#### **Overhanging Vegetation Brooklands**

The vegetation that is obscuring the street light below Brooklands will be trimmed. Dates for the work to be confirmed.

#### **PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

#### **Rural Bus Services**

BANES Council has announced that contracts have been let for existing services including the 179. These will run until August 2020. The BANES Rural Transport Group's passenger survey has been completed and the results are being analysed. The Group is working with BANES to look at the existing bus strategies and how they need to be updated to feed into a new regional bus strategy being created by the West of England Combined Authority (WECA) to ensure similar problems don't occur in future.
